## Understanding & responding to domestic abuse

### What will be covered:

- Develop knowledge and understanding of domestic abuse including; meaning, prevalence and stereotypes.
- To reflect on abuse in context of relationships.
- To explore possible indicators and the effects of abuse including; barriers to leaving.
- To consider application in practice including; appropriate risk assessment and the importance of multi-agency working.
- To develop professional capability and confidence in understanding and responding to domestic abuse.
